Packagizer is a productivity tool designed from the ground up to address the specific printing requirements of digital photographic operations. Packagizer converts digital images to sellable standard photo packages without the previously required cut & paste, multiple documents, and long waits for the computer to perform the task.

Minimize operator cost

Using Packagizer's drag-and-drop technology order entry takes seconds, and an entire day's orders can be entered in minutes. As soon as the order is entered, Packagizer releases the computer and allows the operator go on to other tasks. Packagizer automatically rotates, scales and formats the page to create the requested package. The operator never needs to worry about manipulating digital images in an image-editing application to fit them into a printer format. Packagizer's intuitive user interface allows an operator with no computer background can begin to enter job orders with just a few minutes of training. Operators never need to wait for the printer to be available, and jobs can be added at any time.

Maximize printer throughput

Idle printers are not profitable, so keeping the printer busy is a primary goal. Packagizer formats the next job while the previous job is printing, and downloads it as soon as the printer is ready. All of this activity runs in the background, freeing your computer and operator to do other tasks while Packagizer keeps your orders rolling. Packagizer keeps track of all the jobs entered and gives the operator a clear view of printing progress. In addition to printing formatted packages, Pass-Through mode allows printing pre-formatted images in the same background job queue. If throughput requirements exceed the capability of one printer, additional printers can be added to increase productivity.

Hardware Compatibility

Packagizer runs on Macintosh, Power Macintosh, Windows95 or WindowsNT computers and requires approximately 13 to 23 mb of RAM depending on the printer and output options. Supported printers include KODAK 8600/8650, Sienna Imaging FotoPrint, and Fujix Pictography 3000. Packagizer supports half page operations on the Pictography and FotoPrint in order to minimize wasted materials.
